






## 4 Site Rules



### ALL PERSONNEL MUST

- Sign in and out when arriving and leaving site
- Wear accreditation at all times
- Follow instructions from site management and security
- Work safely and follow all risk assessments
- Keep work areas clean and tidy
- Dispose of waste responsibly

### STRICTLY PROHIBITED

- × Drugs or illegal substances
- × Aggressive behaviour
- × Excessive alcohol consumption
- × Unauthorised vehicles on site
- × Open fires

## 5 Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)



### MANDATORY REQUIREMENT

During build and breakdown periods the following PPE is mandatory in all construction zones. Contractors must supply their own PPE.



### MINIMUM PPE — ALWAYS REQUIRED

- ✓ High visibility vest
- ✓ Safety boots



### ADDITIONAL PPE — WHERE REQUIRED

- ✓ Hard hats
- ✓ Gloves
- ✓ Eye protection
- ✓ Hearing protection
- ✓ Fall arrest equipment for working at height

## 6 Vehicle Movements



### SAFETY RISK

Vehicle movements present a **major safety risk** on event sites. All rules below are strictly enforced.

MAX SPEED



### PEDESTRIAN PRIORITY

Pedestrians **always** have priority over vehicles on site at all times.

#### — VEHICLE RULES

- Hazard lights must be used at all times
- Banksman required when reversing
- Engines off when unloading
- No vehicle movements during public opening hours without authorisation

## 7 Fire Safety



#### — IF YOU DISCOVER A FIRE

- 1 Raise the alarm immediately
- 2 Inform Event Control without delay
- 3 Use a **fire extinguisher** if safe to do so
- 4 Evacuate the area immediately



### FIRE POINTS LOCATED AT

Stages · Trader Areas · Production Compounds  
· All entrance gates



### SMOKING

Only permitted in **designated smoking areas**.

## 8 Medical & Welfare



Medical facilities are located within the main arena and campsite areas.

#### — IF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE IS REQUIRED

- 1 Contact Event Control via radio



### EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS

All emergency communications must be made via **radio to Event Control**.

2 Notify **security or stewarding** teams

3 Direct medical staff to the **incident location**

## 9 Environmental Responsibility



### OUR COMMITMENT

Summer's End aims to minimise environmental impact. All contractors must play their part in protecting the site and surrounding farmland.

- Use designated waste points for all rubbish disposal
- Recycle wherever possible — follow site recycling procedures
- Avoid fuel spills — use drip trays and report any spills immediately to the Site Manager
- Protect farmland and surrounding environment — no vehicles off designated routes
- Leave your work area clean, safe and hazard-free at all times






## 10 Emergency Procedures



### IN AN EMERGENCY

You may hear instructions via radio or public address systems. Always follow instructions from Security, Event Control and Site Management without delay.
